LOVE REFINED Love Obeys

Decision-drivers...

- I follow my <u>emotions</u> "I'll do what I feel like doing..."
- I follow my experience "I'll do what I've always known to do..."
- I follow my culture "I'll do what everyone else is doing..."
- I follow my God "I'll do what God is asking me to do..."

Obedience is less about "<u>what should I do</u>?" and more about "<u>who do I love</u>?" – "Whoever has my commands and obeys them, he is the one who loves me. He who loves me will be loved by my Father, and I too will love him and show myself to him." (John 14:21)

The blessing(s) of obedience...

- The enjoyment of <u>God's love</u> "As the Father has loved me, so have I loved you. Now remain in my love. If you obey my commands, you will remain in my love, just as I have obeyed my Father's commands and remain in His love." (John 15:9-10)
- *The experience of <u>personal joy</u> "I have told you this so that my joy may be in you and that your joy may be complete." (John 15:11)*

The fruit of obedience...

• *A radical love for <u>others</u> – "My command is this: love each other as I have loved you. Greater love has no one than this, that he lay down his life for his friends."* (John 15:12)

No one has ever seen God; but if we love one another, God lives in us and His love is made complete in us. (1 John 4:12)

The motivation of obedience...

• A <u>friendship</u> with Jesus – "You are my friends if you do what I command. I no longer call you servants, because a servant does not know his master's business. Instead, I have called you friends, for everything that I learned from my Father I have made known to you." (John 15:14-15)

Note: a true friend confides in you – "The LORD confides in those who fear Him; He makes His covenant known to them." (Psalm 25:14)

You did not choose me, but I chose you and appointed you to go and bear fruit – fruit that will last. Then the Father will give you whatever you ask in my name. This is my command: Love each other. (John 15:16-17)
